
- Theft from parked vehicles


How to deter crime




Bike Lane Update



- WDCA board strongly opposed design and process
- DOTI did not provide meaningful opportunity for community input
- DOTI acknowledged flaws in design for Quebec St. corridor and impacts on Denver Green School
- DOTI revised design and implementation process
- WDCA continues to monitor DOTI efforts and insist upon designs that benefit both our community and the city at large

Revised Bike Lane Design



Neighborhood bikeway planned for S. Niagara St.




- Phase 1 Revised Schedule
 - August 2020- repaving and bike lane install on Virginia (west of S. Niagara St.)
 - March 2021 install neighborhood bikeway on S. Niagara St. north from DGS to Alameda shared use sidewalk
- Phase 2
 - Additional analysis to be conducted in 2021 to assess whether bike lane can be extended east to Quebec St.


Group Living Ordinance

- WDCA advised Council and City Planning that we strongly oppose the plan
- WDCA supported Inter-Neighborhood Cooperation's (INC) Resolution asking the City to de-bundle the omnibus ordinance changes because of complexity and impacts
- WDCA conducted a survey of Denver's neighborhoods to learn level of awareness and how they stand
- Full City Council vote expected in October
