PROPERTY CHANGES

716 S Poplar St – The sale from the City to Cottonwood Community Association has been completed. The home improvements are beginning. We have invited CCA to attend our Annual Meeting in August. Q/A time will be allotted.

430 S Newport Way – The sale of this property involved a revocation of surprising existing covenants. The two-lot property was acquired by a developer who plans to split the lot much like the original farmhouse lot and build new homes. They cleared off trash and overgrowth and regularly monitor the property as a goodwill gesture to our neighborhood until construction begins.

CYBER CRIMES/PHONE SCAMS

Criminals have ramped up the steam on SCAMS and cybercrimes.

Phone calls from Microsoft, Car Warranty firms and other are SCAMS. NEVER give your personal data to anyone who initiates calls to you unless you expect the call. Random calls are SCAMMERS.

A newer one – you'll see a name in caller ID from out of Colorado area code and the caller says they got a call from your number. You say "no" and they record your voice and they insist on keeping you on the line. Hang up!

Watch bank accounts, personal information sources you use, shopping online. Notify the institution immediately if something is amiss.

If you experience a crime, please notify the Denver Police as well as the Denver District Attorney


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Denver's Near Southeast Area Plan Begins
