Denver's current waste service

- 180,000 customers (and growing)
 - Single family homes & apartments up to 7 units
- Paid for mostly by sales and property taxes
 - · No charge for weekly trash pick up
 - No charge for recycling every-other-week
 - \$9.75/mo. for weekly compost pick up
- 74% of total waste goes to landfill




Long History of Discussions

Proposal: Volume-Based Service Fee



Services Included

- Weekly recycling!*
- Weekly composting for all customers!
- Weekly trash pick up
- Extra trash days/large item pick-up
- Cherry Creek drop-off center
- Education and Outreach
- Customer service

- Annual Programs
 - Leaf Drop
 - Treecycle
 - Mulch Give-away
 - Subsidized HHW pick up
 - Subsidized e-waste drop-off
 - Recycle Your Holiday Lights
 - Appliance recycling
 - Paint recycling
 - Great Denver Cleanup



*Recycling, composting, and trash cost includes staff, trucks, carts, disposal fees, billing system



Cart Sizes & Proposed Monthly Rates



- Customers can mix & match different cart sizes for trash, recycling, and compost
- Fee is charged on the trash cart size only, recycling and compost carts are included

Income-Qualified Instant Rebate

Eligibility = income + number of people in the house (Area Median Income)

- 30% AMI = 100% instant rebate
- 50% AMI = 75% instant rebate
- 60% AMI = 50% instant rebate

Renters will be eligible
