SUBJECT: Washington Virginia Vale Neighborhood Crime and Lighting Review

As requested, the attached report summarizes the reported property offenses and crimes against persons related to the Washington Virginia Vale Neighborhood for January 1st, 2019 through May 31st, 2023 from sunset to sunrise. The statistics are summarized by the offense type.

SUMMARY

- Percentage of nighttime property crime has slightly decreased over the last 4 years
- Percentage of nighttime persons crime spiked in 2021 but has otherwise remained relatively constant over the last 4 years
- Nighttime property crime spiked in September 2020 through January 2021
 Large increase in Motor Vehicle Theft and Theft from Motor Vehicle
- Nighttime persons crimes spiked in January of 2023
 - o Increase in Aggravated Assault
- Public light poles appear to be scarce to intermittent in areas of high-density nighttime property crime and persons crime








Reported Crime Increase: Property – September 2020 through January 2021 Persons – January 2023

September 2020 through January 2021 had a high volume of Motor Vehicle Thefts and Theft from Motor Vehicle reports. This pattern of property crime reflects the area's trends – the majority occurred along the 800 Block of S Oneida Dr and the 7000 Block of Leetsdale Dr. January 2023 had a high volume of Aggravated Assault reports. There may be private lighting, but Denver Police Department does not have that information.
