City Ordinances require residents to remove snow from walks within 24 hours.

The Snow Angels program is an initiative of the Agency for Human Rights and Community Partnerships that is aimed to assist residents in Denver in need of assistance shoveling their front sidewalks during the cold winter months. This is a volunteer service created to avoid fines for noncompliance of clearing pedestrian walkways in front of homes.

Eligible applicants include the following:

- Must be a Denver City & County resident
- Residents or older adults physically unable to shovel
- Neighbors living with a disability
- Financially unable to pay for a service

The Snow Angels program does not:

- Remove snow in driveways or front steps
- Remove down trees/branches on front walks

Winston Downs Community Association/WDCA

WDCA has been an association representing this neighborhood since 1975 (under a couple of different names.) The board is made up of 5-7 people. Positions: President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and Directors.

WDCA falls under City Council District 5, Denver Public Schools District 3.

Because of this neighborhood organization: WDCA is the organization to whom the city is required to notify about changes impacting Winston Downs; WDCA is the organization to, in turn, keep you informed or to hear your concerns; offer neighborhood representation, offer safety representation and hold hosted community gatherings about neighborhood issues and hold social gatherings so you know the neighbors!

WDCA has volunteer chairs for Neighborhood Safety, Welcoming New Residents, Social Events open to all residents. News Delivery, Communications and Neighborhood Clean-up. We have appointed delegates to INC and City advisory groups.

Our monthly Board meetings are generally held via Zoom; however, we also hold separate public meetings to gather opinions, concerns and feedback on issues that impact all residents such as zoning changes, city ordinance changes and safety precaution presentations.

Membership Importance:

Membership is voluntary and still <u>only</u> \$20/per calendar year per household. Your dues support our subscriptions to our website and eNews distribution as well as cover venue costs for public meetings, printed door-to-door notices, signage and hosted neighborhood events (Block party, Garage sale, etc.). Our meetings are public and open to all residents.

Major factors for maintaining low crime are block participation in Neighborhood Watch, plus knowing and looking out for your neighbors.

Recently Reported Crimes in WD

- Theft from vehicles, vehicle theft
- Seasonal package theft from front porches
- Gunshots on Quebec
- Door to door sales pitches- may be fraudulent

Good Deterrents to Crime

- Outside lights on at night and lights on timers inside when away
- Open landscaping near home entries
- Outside cameras, Ring or similar devices
- Mail, newspapers & door flyers removed same day
- Lock vehicles and remove valuables
- Lock home doors, windows when away
- Arrange for snow removal
- Place a No Solicitor sign on your door

Please use 311 when dealing with non- emergency issues like graffiti, property issues, etc. Phone or email 311@denvergov.org

Call 911 when there is a physical crime against persons, and or property or an emergency health problem or fire.

Please report gunshots and street racers EVERYTIME you hear them to 911. Reporting what's happening here is the only way our area gets more police patrol, Shot Spotter cameras and ability to make a case for cameras at main intersections.

Snowy Sidewalks on Quebec

WDCA is working on solutions for sidewalk snow removal along Quebec.

The "Field" at E. Exposition/Quebec

WDCA worked with the City of Denver concerning the large field that homeowners were responsible for mowing. The city agreed to take this on before the election. The city has now reversed its decision to mow this area since the election. We are working to reinstate the promised mowing by prior City leaders.

365 S Quebec – Formerly Watsons

In 2022, WDCA utilized free mediation services provided by the City to negotiate better maintenance and clean up for this property located at Alameda/Quebec. Owners agreed to clear out debris, dead trees and to remove the containers by end of 2022. They have completed part, but not all of their commitment. Neighborhood Inspection is monitoring.
